SMNW Sports Fans: The 2022-2023 Athletic Passes are available now. There are two types of passes:

- 1. Individual Pass: \$60 and admits one for all home events that are not tournaments or post-season KSHSAA events.
- Family Pass: \$150 admits up to four people (no more than two adults) and are good for all home events that are not tournaments or post-season KSHSAA events.

Food Service Meal Reminders:

A little confused about what qualifies as a "Student Meal"? A meal as defined by USDA is described below:

Breakfast – Must contain 3 items and one item must be a fruit or juice.

Lunch – Must contain 3 food components and one component has to be a $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of fruit or vegetable.

Example: If a student only wants a slice of pizza, a slice of pizza by itself is not a meal. A slice of pizza only counts as 2 components – meat and grain. Therefore, since it is only 2 components and there is no fruit or vegetable, this is an ala carte purchase. To qualify for the student meal price, (regular, free or reduced) students need to take a complete meal or they will pay the ala carte price for their items. Ala carte items cannot be charged; students will need to take a complete meal if they do not have money on their account. Please contact Food Service with questions.
